### 3. Until we see Jesus, we are \_\_\_\_\_!

As the parents of the child Jesus brought him in to carry out the rituals of the Law, <u>Simeon took him into his arms and blessed God</u>:

"God, you can <u>now release your servant</u>; release me in peace as you promised. <u>With my own eyes I've seen your salvation</u>; it's now out in the open for everyone to see: A God-revealing light to the non-Jewish nations, and of glory for your people Israel." Luke 2:28-32 (TMNT)

### 4. Never give \_\_\_\_\_\_.

"Show me the path where I should go, O Lord; point out the right road for me to walk. Lead me; teach me; for you are the God who gives me salvation. <u>I have no hope except</u> <u>in you</u>." Psalm 25:4,5 (LB)

# **Definition:** Hope is the confident <u>expectation</u> that God is willing and able to fulfill His promises to us.

"In [God's] great mercy He has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade – kept in heaven for you." 1 Peter 1:4 (NIV)
