What is Faithfulness?

- It is "that which evokes trust and faith, the state of being someone in whom confidence can be placed, faithfulness, fidelity, commitment". That is, a person of who is faithful and committed. He will follow through. You can depend on him.
- "the state of believing on the basis of the reliability of the one trusted, *trust*, *confidence*, *faith*." The application here is that you can put your trust, confidence and faith in someone who is reliable.

How has the Lord been faithful to you this past year?

- a. Key biblical principle is REMEMBER
 - i. Not merely the opposite of "forget"
 - ii. To remember is to actively call to mind with purpose

- b. Genesis 9:16 Whenever the rainbow appears in the clouds, I will see it and remember the everlasting covenant between God and all living creatures of every kind on the earth."
- c. Genesis 30:22 Then God remembered Rachel; he listened to her and enabled her to conceive.
- d. Remembering is a key part of faith...
- e. Remember what He has done
- f. Remember what He has spoken
- g. Remember what He has promised
- h. Take a moment to pray and thank the Lord for His faithfulness this past year
- 2) What promises of God are you holding onto for the coming year?
 - a. As you pray this year, intentionally call to mind the things the Lord has said to you and done for you
 - b. Then trust in His faithfulness... the strong reliability of His nature and character
 - c. Take a moment to commit this year to the Lord and tell Him you trust Him for everything that lies ahead
- 3) What part of your life, your heart, or your world, are you asking the Lord to transform this year?
 - a. Remember that the Lord desires to help you grow and make you more like Jesus
 - b. Remember that His Spirit is in you to guide you, teach you, and transform your mind, heart, and soul
 - c. Take a moment to invite the Lord to help you in the area you most need Him
